

Purpose: To outline Kidney/Pancreas Transplant Programs requirements for the care of end stage renal disease (ESRD) patients

Policy: The Methodist Dallas Transplant Institute will comply with the following:

- 1) The program will directly furnish transplantation and other medical and surgical specialty services required for the care of ESRD patients
- 2) The program will maintain written policies and procedures for ongoing communications with dialysis patients' local dialysis facilities
- 3) The program will furnish inpatient dialysis services directly or under arrangement
- 4) Participate in network activities and cooperate with the ESRD Network designated for the program's geographic area, in fulfilling the terms of the Network's current statement of work
